Homework Contract

Academic success is the number one priority of the Boys & Girls Club of Gardner. Our staff are firmly committed to making sure each member reaches their academic potential. The Power Hour program at the Boys & Girls Club of Gardner is designed to provide club members with a quiet and supportive atmosphere where they can work on their homework assignments. Power Hour staff and volunteers provide academic help as needed, as well as individual tutoring when necessary and available. Power Hour staff will be permitted to coordinate and discuss with a member's school and teachers when necessary to insure that the member is completing all homework to the best of their abilities.

Power Hour is open Monday through Thursday. Parents have the option of setting a daily time limit for their child's participation or requiring the member to stay in Power Hour until their homework is complete. A signed homework contract allows the Boys & Girls Club staff to require the member's attendance in Power Hour in order to complete their homework and check in when they do not have homework. While it is the goal of Power Hour for members to finish their assignments here at the club, this is not always possible. Even if a member is able to finish their assignments at the Club, parents are still strongly encouraged to review their homework with them daily.

It is always within the discretion of the Power Hour staff to determine a member's continued participation in the program. There is an established set of rules that must be obeyed by all members while in Power Hour, of which both parents and members should be aware (*please see rules on back of contract*). These rules are designed with the goal in mind of providing a calm and supportive atmosphere for all participants. If a member proves to be a repeated disruption or refuses to attend Power Hour, parents will be notified and the member will be subject to suspension from Power Hour.

Power Hour Rules

- 1. Members must sign in when entering Power Hour.
- 2. No talking above a whisper.
- 3. Members must submit homework to staff when asked.

- 6. Computer games are not allowed in Power Hour. Computers are for homework use only.
- 7. Staff may dismiss a member from Power Hour at any time if they refuse to follow the rules.
- 8. A member may be suspended from Power Hour for continued disruptive behavior.
